## From David's Desk:

Just received a note left in the church office just before Easter. It was a rather scathing note that read in part that I am of the Devil and so is the church. This note among other things refers to Ezekiel 34, which tells of Israel's false shepherds and 1 John 3:8-10 which tells of those who do not obey the commandment of God to "Love one another."
