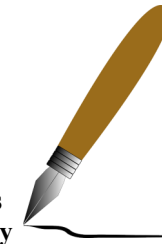

From David’s Desk:

I saw a cartoon this week about Lent. It shows Mary reading a note from Jesus. The note read, “Mom, I am going out into the wilderness for 40 days...to be tempted by Satan. Don’t Worry! Love, J.” Haven’t we all read something like that (or in my case written something like that)? As we move into Lent we face many things, not the least of which is the election season ahead. I was glad to see a rally at the State House urging us to support our elected leaders and to pray for our choices to come. I was reminded of the advice John Wesley gave, “I met with those of our society who had votes in the ensuing election, and advised them: 1. To vote, without fee or reward, for the person they judged most worthy; 2. To speak no evil of the person they voted against; 3. To take care their spirits were not sharpened against those who voted on the other side.” Mr. Wesley spoke those words on June 6, 1774. I think they are still valuable advice as we look toward a long election season.



We observe Lent for 40 days but remember the term 40 days in scripture means a long indeterminate period of time. So is our election season. Remember to pray for wisdom in voting and grace in the results.
