From David’s Desk:

A few years back there was a popular song that had the title “Don’t Worry, Be Happy!” I thought of that song when I saw an article by Ron Edmundson, entitled “Five Suggestions To Help you Worry Less’.

In this article Edmundson reminds us that Jesus said, “Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life” and asks how good are we at obeying that verse.

We are all works in progress but here are the five suggestions for having less worry: (1) Pray More—you can pray or worry, but you can never do both at the same time; (2) Do wise things—When we do the best we can do our hearts are freed from needless worry; (3) Read more - I recommend the Bible, that is where we find hope, trust, and faith spelled out for us by God; (4) Choose your thoughts carefully—read Philippians 4:8. Lots of good things occur every day when we choose to think about them; and (5) Trust more—this is the real key. The more we trust the less we worry. The more we trust the less we worry. The key to trusting him is simple; spend more time with him. Like any healthy relationship it grows stronger with time and effort. The more you know God the more you will love and trust him.
