From David’s Desk:

I ran across an article that contrasted the difference between Discipleship and Cruise Ship culture. It is an interesting contrast. The Cruise Ship Culture has these characteristics:

1. Resource use and decisions are driven by making people happy, comfortable, and satisfied.
2. Ministry is performed by clergy/staff/leaders, on behalf of and in service to members.
3. Members are passive recipients/beneficiaries of ministry services and tasks. (passengers)

Characteristics of a Discipleship Culture are:

1. Resource use and decisions are driven by making disciples
2. Ministry is carried out by all disciples (clergy and lay) on behalf of the mission.
3. Members, as disciples, seek to hear and live out their own call to ministry.
4. Clergy/staff guide, equip, and empower lay disciples in their ministry.

Biblical basis for these are Mark 12:23-31, 1 Peter 2:5, Luke 10, Matthew 16:24 and Mark 10:28.

The question we need to ask ourselves is this: What ship are we on? Is it the Cruise Ship or Discipleship? With which do you want to be associated?

I urge you to take a hard look at yourself and decide which ship you are on. If you do not think you are on the right ship, let us move in a new direction. It is not too late. The ship has not left the dock!

Let us move in the direction on Discipleship for our Lord in the days to come. We will be starting a Bible Study on Discipleship in about three weeks. Look for the opportunity to grow in our faith in the days ahead.
