From David’s Desk:

In an article, *Four Steps to Becoming a Great Church of Any Size*, Karl Vaters breaks it down like this:

Love Jesus. Love your neighbor. With all your heart, soul, mind, and strength. Then teach others to do the same. Wholeheartedly. Without compromise. And never give up.
