From David’s Desk:

I know that at the founding of this nation the founding fathers had to deal with fear: Fear of a Nation that was making demands; fear from within (the loyalist to England); fear of the future; and fear of what freedom might really bring. They stepped out in spite of fear and so can we.

All of us must learn how not to "fear the fear." The devil brings fear, but you can choose not to bow your knee to it. David said, "What time I am afraid, I will...trust... in You" (Psalm 56:3). I believe we can say that when God leads you to step out in an area to do something new, or leads you to make a bigger commitment, you may (or probably will) feel fear. However, if you're sure God told you to do it, put your trust in Him and go forward.

We have to make a decision to either stand still in fear or move with God. We must be willing to move in a new direction and be willing not only to pray but to try new things. If your forefathers had not been willing to move in a new unproved direction we would still be part of the British Empire.

We certainly don't want to move in the flesh or out of God's timing, but when God is moving, you can't be afraid to move with Him. We have to make a choice. To be lead by our heads or follow the leading of the Holy Spirit.
