From David's Desk:

As we look to the future I think a lot of our direction depends on our attitude. I found the quote from Charles Swindoll about attitude;

"The longer I live, the more I realize the impact of attitude on life. Attitude to me, is more important than the past, than education, than money, than circumstances, than failures, than successes, than what other people think, or say or do. Attitude will make or break a company...a church...a home. The remarkable thing is we have a choice every day regarding the attitude we will embrace for that day. We cannot change the inevitable. The only thing we can do is play on the one string we have, and that is our attitude...I am convinced that life is 10% what happens to me, and 90% how I react to it. And so it is with you...we are in charge of our attitudes." So as we move to the future here at Greene Street let us approach the opportunities ahead with a positive attitude. Do not limit God to our human sized dreams and aspirations. Let the Holy Spirit work within you and dream "God-Sized Dreams" led by the Holy Spirit.
