I know that you will enjoy your new pastor Rev. Dr. Robert Walker. He is a really wonderful, talented person. He will be a new voice to proclaim God’s Word here in new and exciting ways.

It is a time not to look back but a time to look forward to the potential of this location in the sharing of ministry in Christ’s name. I recall the words of John F. Kennedy in his 1st inaugural address:

“So let us begin anew--remembering on both sides that civility is not a sign of weakness, and sincerity is always subject to proof. Let us never negotiate out of fear. But let us never fear to negotiate.

Let both sides explore what problems unite us instead of belaboring those problems which divide us...

Let both sides seek to invoke the wonders of science instead of its terrors. Together let us explore the stars, conquer the deserts, eradicate disease, tap the ocean depths and encourage the arts and commerce.

Let both sides unite to heed in all corners of the earth the command of Isaiah--to "undo the heavy burdens . . . (and) let the oppressed go free."

And if a beach-head of cooperation may push back the jungle of suspicion, let both sides join in creating a new endeavor, not a new balance of power, but a new world of law, where the strong are just and the weak secure and the peace preserve.”

Wise words to follow in these times.
