This is a special time for people in the United Methodist Connection. Many churches including this one are having a change in pastoral leadership. I would like to invite you into a 40 day prayer vigil beginning on this Pentecost Sunday.

3. The churches of The South Carolina Annual Conference as many of its churches are experiencing a change in pastoral leadership.
4. The South Carolina Annual Conference as it struggles with issues that will impact its ministry in the future.
5. The United Methodist Church as it struggles with division and searches for a way to be united in ministry.
6. The entire nation as we struggle to be a nation that can live together in harmony with each other and our neighbors in the world.
