From David’s Desk:  
How does Jesus speak to you?  
Last night I spent some time reading and thinking about an article on the multilingualism of Jesus. In essence, this article gave a good argument that Jesus in this historical perspective probably spoke at different times the following languages: Hebrew, Aramaic, Greek, and Latin. He probably spoke Hebrew in the synagogue; Aramaic to the people everyday; Greek in official language ; and Latin when speaking to Pilate. All of this points to a Jesus that can and will to this day speak to everyone who will listen. I think this is an important thing to note in this season of Pentecost to know a God that speaks to each of us in our own tongue through the Holy Spirit.  
But perhaps we need to think about how we listen for Jesus to speak to us. Do we take time in our prayer life to allow the Holy Spirit to lead or do we go off in our own direction without hearing the guidance that our Lord through Jesus provides, do we study the scriptures and meditate on that so we can hear the voice of God through his word.? I have a pastor friend who had a member tell him that they were leaving the church because they were not being fed enough!  
His reply was telling. He asked “Don’t you have a pet dog?” “Yes!” he replied. Then the pastor said, “Would your pet survive if it only ate one time per week?”  
Are you partaking of the Word of God through prayer, bible study, or meditation (listening) more than once a week?
