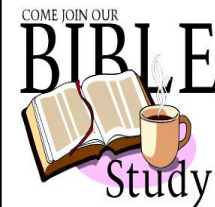
That responsibility is our “Skin in the Game” because we can be the difference in the lives of those we love and care about.
