During June 2015, the SC Annual Conference adopted as its mission project this year the “Imagine No Malaria” program. Back then I decided to put all my loose change in a old water bottle I had. I have done that everyday since then.

Last week Maria said I might want to empty that bottle before it got so heavy I could not lift it. So I did!

Well that little bit of effort every day netted \$367.36 for the Imagine No Malaria campaign. That mission project buys mosquito nets for children in underdeveloped countries. Those nets really do save lives. It cost \$10 to provide a net for a child. So my minuscule effort provided funds for 36 children.


Really this was not a great effort. It just takes a little discipline to put that spare change away at the end of each day.
