From David's Desk:

In the Revised Common Lectionary, this Sunday is traditionally called Ascension Sunday. This is a recognition of the Ascension of Jesus back to the Father after his period of instruction of his disciples following his death and resurrection.

During this time Jesus gave instructions such as charging us with continuing His ministry on earth.

There is a cartoon going around that depicts the ascension of Jesus. In this cartoon, Jesus is ascending into heaven and one of the disciples is saying "Where? Where? I can't see Him!" The caption is "Ascension Deficit Disorder". At first I chuckled when I read that cartoon, then after some thought I realized that the cartoon depicts our dilemma here. So often we get carried away with the activities of "church" as an institution or a building, that we fail to realize that the church is us, wherever we are. We cannot see Jesus because the activities and maintaining are too much of an effort that we overlook the real purpose of what we are to be about.

Jesus taught us during those forty days between his resurrection and his ascension that we are to be about "Making Disciples" for him. Our Methodist Church's mission statement is "To make Disciples of Jesus Christ for the Transformation of the World."

When we do that then we always can see Jesus in all we meet and others can see Jesus in us. Great way to avoid "Ascension Deficit Disorder"! In the Grip of His Grace,
