In last Sunday’s sermon I alluded to the song by Jean Osbourne, “What If God Were One of Us”. It had a special meaning to me as I pondered the events of the past two weeks.

A terrible tragedy has occurred. Many have lost all their material possessions. In the Conference Center as we began our Disaster Recovery operations, it was heart breaking to hear the damage reports of the storm’s and the flood’s damage on homes, churches, and public works.

As I watched one of the news reports, I saw people who were homeless due to floods. I saw heroes that risked their lives to save others, and I watched as ordinary people pitched in to help folks salvage all they could. I thought of the lyrics of the song, “In The Grip Of His Grace”, “If God had a face, what would it look like and would you want to see? If seeing meant that you would have to believe in things like Heaven and in Jesus and the Saints, and all the Prophets” Then it struck me. YES! I want to see for in those faces I do see the face of God. Those people who are in need, the ones who responded to the need, the concerned church as it responds to need, that is the face of God!
